Workshop Painting and Sketching Clothed Models

Saturday 30 September 10am-4pm Charles Morris Hall Tyttenhanger, free parking Tutor Bridget Tompkins (£35 fee and booking required)

Using the late Charles Reid as inspiration, Bridget will guide us through exploring how to sketch, followed by painting the clothed model in watercolour. The nature of watercolour will allow us to embrace a loose and lively style, observing colours and textures as we work. It will be an informal and interesting workshop. The morning model will be joined by a second model for the afternoon session. There will be changes of outfits.

What you need to bring: Waterproof apron or old shirt, lunch and a mug for drinks (provided). Water colour pencils and a good set of paints. Some rougher drawing paper will be best to begin with, & 300g watercolour paper for the painting – preferably larger than a4. Smooth paper is great for this subject but not essential. Some wax candle cut into bits for resist/highlight effects is helpful. Rubber, pencil sharpeners.
